Our Aims

Our school:

Responsibilities

- co-ordinate safe waste disposal from the site;
- assist in maintaining a clean site;
- monitor correct bins are used for recycling;
- empty waste bins.

Eco-Committee

The Eco-Committee has the responsibility to:

- monitor and report on the litter situation across the whole school;
- listen and respond to suggestions from the school community;
- promote anti-litter messages across the school and wider community.
