What is Child Protection?

At Caerau Primary School we think that your health, safety and wellbeing are important. We respect you and want to keep you safe. We teach you how to recognise risks and how to stay safe. We are a right respecting school, and we ensure that every child has access to their rights.

Tell someone if someone is:

- Bullying you.
- Saying things that upset you. Or make you uncomfortable.
- Touching you.
- Hitting or hurting you.
- Taking your things.
- Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone



Who can you talk to?

If you are worried about something you can talk to an adult in school. This could your teacher or the school's safeguarding or wellbeing team.
